Surveyed Depths – Harwich Deep Water Channel – Update 3


Mariners are advised that hydrographic surveys have identified reduced depths in the Harwich Deep Water Channel. The minimum available depth of water on the centreline is approx. 15.6m below chart datum, with shallower sections towards the channel edges (as per survey data below).

This local notice to mariners is cumulative and replaces notice 08-2024 which is now withdrawn.






Surveyed 1st-2nd May 2024


















Survey Data - Beach End to NW Beach - 29-30/01/2024








Survey Data - Beach End to Platters - 29-30/01/2024


